
Freestyle Wraparound Club – Attendance & Behaviour Policy

Updated August 2025

Attendance

Freestyle Wraparound Club aims to create a welcoming environment where children want to attend regularly and enjoy taking part in planned activities.

For some clubs—particularly sports-based ones—attendance is important so that children can build skills over time and apply them in games. Missing several sessions can mean missing key learning opportunities.

We ask parents and carers to:

- Inform us if their child will miss more than one session in a row.
- Ensure their child arrives with the correct clothing and any required equipment.

If a child misses sessions:

- If a child misses 3 or more sessions without explanation, we will contact parents or carers to check if there are any issues we can help with.
- If we do not receive a response, we may check with the school to confirm the child's attendance there.
- For pupil premium-funded places: if a child misses a session without contact, their funded place may be offered to another child.

Collection & Register Procedure:

- Children are collected from their teacher by club staff.
- A register is taken when they arrive, transferring them into our care.

Behaviour Expectations

We expect all children to:

- Respect staff, other children, and the club environment.
- Follow instructions from staff.
- Take part in activities without disrupting others.

Unacceptable behaviour will not be tolerated. Staff will always try to manage issues within the group in line with our Behaviour Policy.

If behaviour is repeatedly unsafe or disruptive:

1. Parents or carers will be contacted.
2. The child may be asked to miss one or more sessions while the situation is reviewed.
3. If behaviour does not improve, the child may be permanently excluded from the club.

No refunds will be issued in cases where a child is removed from the club due to their behaviour.

Refusal or Exclusion from Clubs or Camps

Freestyle Wraparound Club reserves the right to refuse or exclude any child from attending if:

- Their behaviour puts themselves or others at risk.
- They repeatedly prevent others from enjoying activities.
- They refuse to participate in a way that disrupts the session.

All decisions will be made by the Club Director, based on reports from staff. The child's school will be notified if they are excluded.

By following this policy, we ensure that children are kept safe, parents understand their responsibilities, and the Club operates smoothly for everyone.
